



Open and Affirming

We should have an online store up and running for the rest of the congregation to make orders soon; no meeting in Dec. Pastor Paris showed members the final version of the tee shirt. She has collected size information from all the youth (toddler through high school) and has placed



the first order. The Congregational Grant that was secured covers the cost of all the youth shirts. The printing company, Phelps, is establishing a website, so members will be able to purchase merchandise online going forward. An assortment of items will be offered including hats, quarter-zip long-sleeve tops, reusable shopping bags, and sweatshirts. Muscatine County LGBTQIA+ Coalition Background: Progress Muscatine president Jessica Brackett approached Faith UCC and several other local groups who promote full inclusion for the LGBTQ+ community to form a new Muscatine County LGBTQIA+ Coalition. The proposal was brought before the Vestry and support was given. Deb Hagy and Jessica Brackett recently met with the Community Foundation for possible assistance in becoming the fiscal agent for this group. No decision on how funds will be managed has been made at this time. The ONA committee members agreed that the coalition is a work in progress and the nature of our committee's involvement will need to be defined at a later date. ONA will not meet in December. 
Harmony Guild

VESTRY NOTES FROM MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2023

Deacons – Stewardship report with pledge update: currently at \$111,000 with 49 pledges. Last year there were 64 pledging units for \$133,953. There is still time for more pledges to come in and we need to remind people about 'planned giving' options too.

Elders – Staff report; resignation of Beth Elshoff. Evaluations completed. Job descriptions were reviewed with each employee so the descriptions can be updated. Christian Education: Beth is stepping down as director beginning Dec. 31st and the committee will work with the elders to update the job description and needs before recruiting for next year. The Elders are clarifying the pastor's job description and the grant of authority that belongs to the pastor and the grant of authority held by the Vestry. Rev. Jonna Jensen will be consulted, and the Elders hope to have a draft soon.


Trustees – The Congregational votes will be taken December 3, 2023, for HVAC (rooftop units; through Kelly's estimated at \$55,000). Mudjacking finished. Still need to schedule a parsonage walk through. Church cleanup day was Nov. 4th. Mike Hartman did the walkthrough and gave us suggestions on fire safety needs. First aid kits have been purchased along with CPR masks. They will be placed in the fellowship area and the basement hallway for easy access. We are considering getting an AED and plan to have training on CPR and AED in the near future. Looking at possible consultant in active shooter safety for the church. Our tornado shelters are the basement hallways and the choir room. They need to be marked as such. A fire extinguisher needs to be purchased for the sacristy and we need to contact MG Fire and Safety to do our annual walkthrough. To note: Exits include the main door, north parking lot, lower door, and the sacristy door. The front doors need to be replaced because they don't always lock, and it is not ADA approved. Our safety policy/ procedures mention a 'Response Team' made up of two people on the Vestry who would hear reports of misconduct and disciplinary action. We currently do not have this team set up. 2 people will be appointed in January 2024 from the Vestry. Bell tower update- Dan Huss met with a couple of contractors to get bids. He also contacted Lewis Industrial Services for ideas. It would be fun to get the congregation involved by holding a challenge to submit a possible new design for a new bell tower.

Pastor Paris – Continuing the work on the Church manual/handbook for the whole scope of the church, including job descriptions along with the Elders. Pastor Paris needs a team of 3-4 members to serve on a Pastor-Parish Relations Team. We welcomed six new members in October, and more are interested, they can communicate with Pastor Paris on details. The pastor has done two funerals since last month's meeting: Carol Lane and Sylvia Trumbull. We have been asked to be part of an ecumenical mid-week Lent soup supper/Lenten discussion – that will be hosted at Wesley Methodist Family Life Center: consensus to participate. Five congregations are already involved and the Clark House and MCSA will be invited. One week would be ours to make soups and Pastor Paris will lead the message and discussion. Monday, December 25th -30 Pastor Paris's Vacation, Office is closed 25, 26, & 29.

Unfinished Business -Tom Emerick, Scott Warren, and Tim Stelzner met to discuss technology at the church. A long-term plan was developed, and priorities can be identified. The plan includes things like a portable camera, speakers, and two TVs downstairs as well as a new 360-degree PTZ camera for the sanctuary and more. This will take 2-3 years to complete. A New Church Directory with possible new database update (Bill Creasey). We are aiming for an electronic directory plus more. Deb, Bill, and Julie are working to update our bylaws and constitution, especially looking at the Constitution regarding new members and voting.

New Business

The congregational Life Grant thank you notes should be turned in to the office to be shared with the church, via the VOF monthly newsletter, be considerate of deadlines.. Recruit four new vestry members for next year to replace the 4 leaving the vestry at year's end, plus other elected positions. (Deb, Julie, Dave, and Frantz will have fulfilled their terms) Annual reports coming up! If you are in a committee, please turn in a report to the office. A motion was made to put the kitchen cabinet on Facebook Marketplace. Motion carried.
